

NOTICE — LATE PUBLICATION OF ANNUAL GOVERNANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY RETURN 2025/26 AND MISSED EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS

TWYWELL PARISH COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the Exercise of Public Rights period required under Regulation 15 of the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 (as amended) was not conducted within the statutory timeframe for the year ended 31 March 2026.

As a smaller authority with income/expenditure not exceeding £25,000, Twywell Parish Council is required to publish its Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), Internal Audit Report and supporting documents, and to allow a minimum period of 30 working days, including the first 10 working days of the appointed period, during which any local government elector may inspect and question the accounts, before conclusion.

This requirement was not met for the 2025/26 financial year.
